

Often flying under the radar due to their small production, Cigliuti's wines can be approachable young but are generally meant to age, in particular the wines from their prized Serraboella vineyard.

CASCINA BARICCHI



Natale Simonetta is one of those somewhat idiosyncratic winemakers with his own style and ideas. He has a Barbaresco made from 100% Nebbiolo Rosé (clone) that is at once rich and expressive, a 15-year release Barbaresco Riserva, a Timorasso wine aged for nine years in used barrels, as well as a sparkling Moscato made partially from iced grapes dedicated to his mother, among other things.

Dolcetto can pose quite the conundrum; a historically popular local wine that is nevertheless difficult to grow (fragile buds, poor vigour) to vinify (reductive) but there are villages and producers who are dedicated to doing justice to this variety. One of the most established in the Dogliani zone, Chionetti makes exemplary Dolcetto that is fruity and crunchy with a characteristic tannic finish.

A familiar narrative in Italian wine is that of a wine (or food for that matter) that exists in only one or a few villages, kept alive or revived from extinction due to one individual's passion. This is the story of Marco Crivelli and the Ruché wine in Castagnole Monferrato, near the town of Asti. While the Ruché is definitely worth seeking out with its expressive floral and baking spice flavours, Crivelli's Grignolino is also noteworthy and lovely, food-friendly wine in its own right.

FORTETO DELLA LUJA



A small winery in one of Italy's smallest DOCs, Loazzolo, Forteto della Luja is a producer dedicated to sustainable practices, walking the talk with solar panels, a manual press and two horses on the estate, as well as a backyard that is a designated WWF biodiversity oasis, well before sustainability became fashionable. The wines come from steep, high altitude (400-500m) vineyards and are traditional in style, with restrained fruit and a classical purity and elegance.

The Alto Piemonte wine region is currently experiencing a revival of interest, thanks to the efforts of people like Cristiano Garella, a young oenologist who is one of the figureheads of this movement. Cristiano consults for over a dozen wineries in the area and often communicates the history and terroir of this area, speaking of things like super-volcanoes, acidic PH soils and the beauty of the Vespolina variety. Le Pianelle is a relatively new project, piecing together old vineyards parcel by parcel but their Bramaterra wine is worthy of attention, a Nebbiolo-based wine from red porphyry sandy soils of volcanic origin.

COLOMBERA & GARELLA



At Colombera & Garella, Cristiano Garella works with his long-time friend Giacomo Colombera and his family, farming nine and a half hectares in the Masserano district at the meeting point of the Lessona and Bramaterra zones. The farming here is sustainable with no chemicals used, while winemaking is honest and straightforward, with the intention to express the character of the vineyard and the native varieties planted here.

We are in the northern valley of Valtellina, another frontier of Nebbiolo where the wines are lighter but with an alpine freshness and particular spicy, mineral flavours. Within this small and closely-knit appellation, ArPePe stand out for their consistent quality and careful attention to detail, notably in giving their wines, especially the single vineyard Riservas, gentle, extended ageing in large wooden casks to best express the ethereal, delicate qualities of this terroir.

Alto Adige (in Italian) aka Südtirol (in German) is a special landscape both extreme and beautiful – full of glacial valleys, steep mountainous slopes and a great diversity of rock soils. The varieties planted here are mostly of French and Germanic origin, with Pinot Bianco surprisingly the hero of the region and of exceptional quality. We love the fresh acidity, beautiful purity and clean minerality of these wines.

Damijan Podversic is one of the most respected winemakers of the amber wine movement in the Gorizian hills of Friuli. There is a great sensitivity and attention here, with respect to growing cycle of the vines and decisions in the cellar. The focus here is on skin-macerated wines from local grapes, with long macerations followed by long ageing in large Slavonian oak casks.

Applying traditional techniques with a modern outlook has resulted in top quality Prosecco, including their single vineyard Particella wines.
